However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

. Do not open until ready to use. Dust will form on collar during storage. Do not get dust in mouth or eyes. Take the collar out of the packaging and stretch to full length. The tabs that held the collar in place will fall off when stretching; pull on any remaining tabs to remove them.
